WESTERN AUSTRALIA

Wine production in Western Australia is focused on premium quality rather than volume and the regional highlight is Margaret River. This area has developed a solid reputation for world class wines and Juniper Estate is a great example.

Juniper Estate, Margaret River

Founded in 1973, Juniper Estate was at the time one of just six wineries in the region alongside Moss Wood, Cullen, Vasse Felix, Cape Mentelle, and Woodlands. The wines show the lovely purity of fruit associated with Margaret River.

NEW SOUTH WALES

This is a region of contrasts with expansive sun-soaked plains and cool, cloudy and frequently rainy hills. Along its border the vast Murray River allows for successful agriculture in the otherwise hot and arid Murray Darling region.

Trentham Estate, Murray River Valley

Situated in an irrigated portion of the Murray River valley, Trentham Estate produces a range of interesting wines, including a very Australian version of northern Italy's Nebbiolo grape and the sweet Noble Taminga. They are also responsible for the production of the two good value Murphy's Vineyard wines.

VICTORIA

A classic and increasingly world-renowned style from Victoria is the fortified wine of Rutherglen. Made from either Muscat or Muscadelle grapes these full-bodied, concentrated wines can vary in their sweetness levels, but are usually somewhat sweeter than Port. The Pfeiffer Muscat is particularly fine and luscious with nicely balanced sugar and acidity bringing out the deliciously rich, raisiny fruit flavours.

And the Reserve Shiraz has ripe plum fruits, vanilla oak and creamy tannins.

Still an entirely family-run estate, Mitchell's produce an excellent range of wines in the Clare Valley notable for their well-defined fruit and longevity in the cellar. They were an early adopter of screwcap closures which have proved to be excellent for preserving the fine fruit of the wines over many years ageing. The dry, lemony Semillon is a new addition this year. With purity, intensity and lovely balance it is delicious young but will age.

Pask, Hawke's Bay

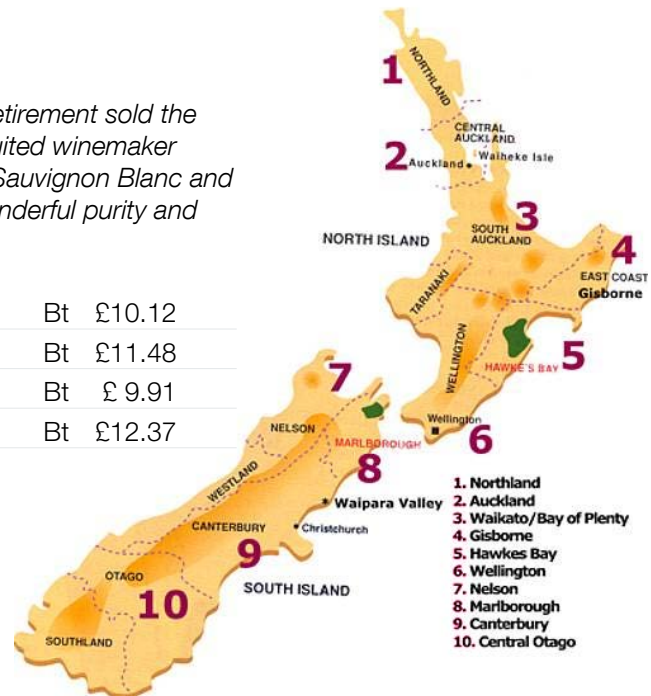

It is concentrated and complex with impressive freshness, reminiscent of Pomerol from a ripe vintage.

CHILE

The Chilean red wine scene tends to revolve around Merlot and Cabernet and so we are pleased to expand the repertoire to include excellent examples of Carmenère and Pinot Noir. The Reserve Pinot Noir from Santa Alba was a particular revelation. In other varieties the Santa Alba Carmenère provides a more concentrated step up from Los Coches and the Toro de Piedra Gran Reserva has impressive weight of luscious bramble fruit flavours. The Los Vascos wines, from the Lafite-Rothschild stable deliver a measure of style, complexity and elegance that would be twice the price if it had come from Bordeaux.

Of other styles, we have extended our selection of outspoken vegan wines with the Proudly Vegan rosé and for those of a sweeter tooth the Toro de Piedra Sauvignon Semillon has rich, honeyed flavours balanced by tangy acidity.

It remains the case that by far the top selling wine style from America is white Zinfandel, a blush, off-dry rosé. The wines themselves can vary in sweetness with Compass Point somewhat less sweet than Water's Edge for example. For other styles, the California sunshine means that it is balance rather than ripeness that is a potential problem, especially for Chardonnay and Pinot Noir.

These two producers have quite different approaches, Musar being the more traditional and even in the Jeune Red, which sees no oak ageing, there are complex flavours from natural yeast fermentation. The flagship wine, Château Musar, is aged for at least seven years before release, but for a wine of similar character at less of a 'fine wine' price the Hochar Red is highly recommended.
